

### Performance Safety Regulations

These regulations are in place to ensure the safety of our guests. Strict compliance is necessary in order to perform. Be sure to share this information with your staff and performers.



If your band is performing in the *Welcome to the Magic* standstill performance at the Transportation and Ticket Center, these safety regulations must also be followed. Also note that equipment cannot be pre-set at this location.

### Flags, Batons & Poms

- Flags & batons are to march no more than two across, and stay at least five feet from the audience.
- If using poms, or if not using equipment, march no more than three across.
- Swing flags are recommended and are restricted to spins only.
- Flag slams and tosses are not permitted.
- Long pole flags may only be spun when held at the center of the pole where the silk attaches.
- Baton tosses are restricted to three revolutions.

Bayonets, sabers, knives, or fire batons are not permitted.

### Rifles

- Functional firearms are not permitted.
- The only rifles that are permitted as part of your performance are the standard white, spinning, prop rifles. Rifles that may be perceived as authentic firearms are not permitted.
- Prop rifles are restricted to single tosses only.
